ROMANIAN AS A FOREIGN LANGUAGE (RFL)

– about the programme –

- ❖ once the number of credits in the curriculum is met, a **Preparatory Year Certificate*** is issued which is necessary for foreign students' registration in Romanian Universities;

- ❖ applicants for registration in the 1st year of undergraduate studies in a Romanian university who have learnt Romanian on their own, may take a language competence exam and be issued a **Language Competence Certificate** (language competence level B2 within the CEFR** system of validation of language ability);

- ❖ language teaching is based on modern communicative methods and interactive learner-centered classroom activities;

- ❖ practice activities are aimed at rapid and sustainable language development;

- ❖ the teaching staff working on this programme are well trained and experienced in modern methods and techniques related to the teaching of both Romanian and foreign languages.
